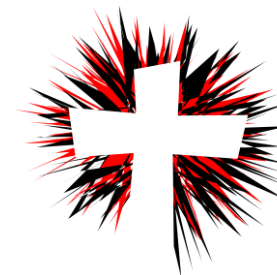
## **Launch of New Dawn Diocesan Magazine**
