What does World Mission Sunday actually support?

The needs of mission dioceses vary greatly, anything from a motorbike so a priest can celebrate Mass in a remote village, to a community hall that will allow people to gather in safety, or more urgently providing vaccinations and medicines to protect vulnerable children in parish dispensaries.

In essence World Mission Sunday provides basic infrastructure by helping communities build schools, clinics, parish halls and churches. It prepares future leaders and carers of the Church by supporting the training of sisters, priests, religious brothers and catechists. It supports missionary programmes that protect and care for children's spiritual and physical wellbeing by offering safe shelter, healthcare, education and hope for the future.
