

Masses with Congregations – Welcome Back

We are delighted that we can, so far, continue to have Masses with congregations of 50 people in our churches, however as Covid is still around we ask that you adhere to the following:

Kilvine Defibrillator Group - The voluntary group overseeing the upkeep of the Defibrillators have been notified that they are no longer fit for purpose as they were purchased in 2008. If the community would like the 15 A.E.D.'s to be replaced a quotation has been received and it will cost between €25,000 and €30,000. Did you know it is an offence to allow your pet to foul in a public area. Pet owners who fail to clean up after their animals face on the spot fines of €150 rising to €3,000 for those convicted of not paying the original penalty. While the majority of dog owners take full responsibility for their pets behaviour, there is a small minority of owners who do not clean up after their dogs whilst out walking. Contact with dog excrement can cause toxocarriasis which can lead to illness such as dizziness, nausea, asthma or seizures and can also contain Ecoli and other parasites which can cause loss of vision. **Please think of others in the community who like to walk the same paths/roadways, especially older people and those with young children.**


