But your joy was great when he rose from the dead, victorious over the powers of evil.

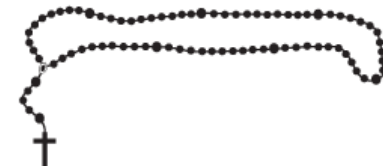
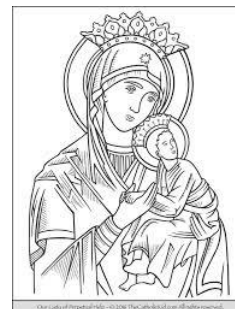
Mother of Sorrows, help us through the trials and disappointments of life.
