Cathedral Evening Prayer
to Mark the Official Opening of the World Meeting of Families
Archbishop Michael Neary and Dean Alistair Grimason will lead an Ecumenical celebration of evening prayer in the **Cathedral of the Assumption Tuam on Tuesday August 21st at 7.30 pm.** This celebration will begin with the tolling of the Cathedral Bells. Archbishop Neary will light the WMOF2018 Candle to mark the Official Opening. All are welcome to attend this Evening Prayer.

Schedule of Events at Knock for Visit of Pope Francis - From 8.30am on the morning of Sunday August 26th, there will be a '**Gathering Event**' until the arrival of the Holy Father. It will focus on the Story of Knock through Apparition witnesses testimonies. Music for the occasion will be provided by Knock Parish Choir with guest musicians and soloists. Upon arrival, the Holy Father will move through the assembly in the Pope Mobile arriving at the Apparition Chapel at 10am for private prayer. Afterwards His Holiness will deliver a short address and lead pilgrims in the Angelus Prayer. **After the departure of the Holy Father, there will be a concelebrated open-air Mass with Fr Richard Gibbons as the main celebrant and homilist. Please note that this will be a part of the official ticketed event.**

Transport to Knock for Papal Visit - A free bus shuttle service will operate from Claremorris train station to take people to Knock. However, as there may be long waiting times for this service, a 14 seater bus can be arranged from **Ballindine to Ballyhowley**, Knock, returning after 1pm when Mass concludes. People will however have to walk the 2.8km (1.75 miles) into Knock as there is no parking near the shrine. ***There will be a fee of €15 for this bus service.*** If you are interested please leave your **name and contact number** on the sheet in the church porch by **Wednesday 21st August (latest)** As this is not a seated event and you will be standing for some time – you may, if you wish, bring a small folding chair/stool with you.
