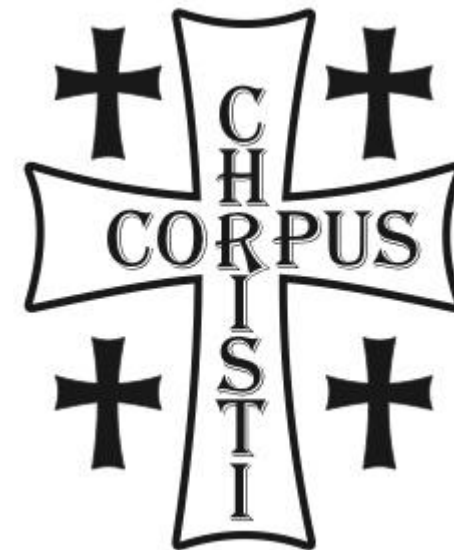

- **Pall Bearers, Fr. O'Connor & Blessed Sacrament**

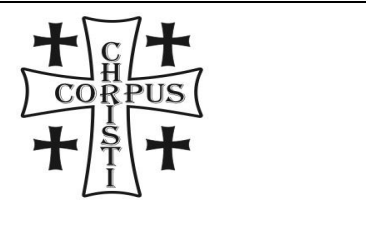
