Earlier this year Pope Francis met with Greta Thunberg. He encouraged her to continue her work and assured her that the climate strikes had his support. The Pope sees that care for our world is not just one more good deed that we might choose to take up, but is integral to Christian faith. He insists that as 'we come together to take charge of this home which has been entrusted to us,' we are not responding to some temporarily 'hot' topic in the culture, nor are we motivated by selfish self-interest because of the threat we face. Rather, we care for the earth because we know *'that all the good which exists here will be taken up into the heavenly feast' (Laudato Si 244)*. Our ecological mandate is an eschatological mission!
