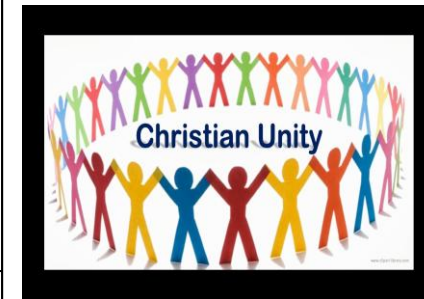
When the song of the angels is stilled,
