It prepares future leaders and carers of the Church by supporting the training of sisters, priests, religious brothers and catechists. It supports missionary programmes that protect and care for children's spiritual and physical wellbeing by offering safe shelter, healthcare, education and hope for the future.

**We feel a vague wish to help others,**

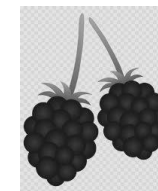
**a desire to be generous,**
