*In this life you embraced them with your tender love;*

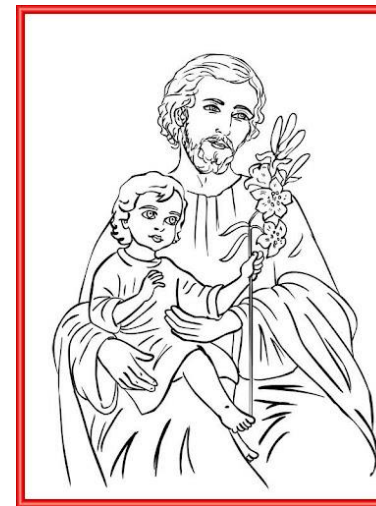
*Deliver them now from every evil and bid them eternal rest.*

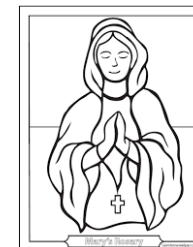
